TRIP HIGHLIGHT

Wrecks of Abu Nuhas - Giannis D, Carnatic, Chrisoula K and Kimon M - are all suitable for recreational diving. At a depth range of 5-30m, their proximity to each other is what makes Abu Nuhas an especially notable wreck diving site. Covered in both soft and hard corals, the wrecks are an underwater dream for the avid photographer. Easy access to the machine rooms and engine room on both the Chrisoula K and Giannas D make it a perfect site for the explorer as well.

The SS Thistlegorm is one of the most renowned wrecks in the world, regarded as a giant underwater museum and a special piece of history. Having sunk in 1941 after a bomb attack, today the Thistlegorm lies at 15-30m and offers a playground for divers that includes military trucks and motorcycles as well as boots, ammunition and a lot more.

Rosalie Moller ship of the SS Thistlegorm (and bombed just the day after) Rosalie Moller is located at 30-50m, making it suitable for experienced divers only. Covered in hard and soft coral, the wreck also attracts a range of species, including barracudas, tuna, jackfish and trevallies; meanwhile glass fish, lion fish and groupers can be spotted inside the wreck.

Big Brother: A 4t00-meter long island offering fabulous wreck diving and wall diving. The wreck of the Numidia lies on the northern tip between 10 and 80 meter. The north-west side of the island houses the wreck of the Aida. On every section of this reef the wall is covered with corals and life.

Little Brother: Boasts a very high concentration of life within a very small area.

Fan coral forests, overhangs, hard and soft corals in a variety of astonishing colours... and of course there are plenty of fish! With regular sightings of hammerheads, thresher sharks, grey sharks and white tip reef sharks, at the right time of year.

Payment & Cancellation policy

Payment Policy

- 25% is needed for confirmation

Cancellation Policy

Changes to price after contract has been sent

A minimum of 14 days notice will be given before such a surcharge becomes effective.
- Increases in transportation costs (including fuel costs) increases in state taxes and duties (i.e. embarkation/disembarkation fees, sales taxes etc.) Currency fluctuations.

Changes to the Itinerary and Services

- All Liveaboard itineraries/harbors are subject to various unpredictable changes including weather conditions, and changes in Egyptian Government approvals.
- Discovery for touristic investment reserves the right, if necessary, to change an itinerary during a trip (i.e. due to weather conditions or any other reasons etc.).
- Whilst Discovery liveboards make every effort we cannot guarantee diving at specific sites. In adverse weather conditions the guides and captain of the boat will have the final decision as to which dive sites to visit to ensure that the guests, staff and boats safety is not compromised in any way. If in the unfortunate event that dives are missed or dive sites are not reached due to weather conditions or other unforeseeable changes which may also lead the inability to deliver any agreed upon services, there will be no refund or compensation provided.

Cancellation/Boat change due to unpredictable reasons

- Each liveaboard is operated on minimum number of booking per boat. In the event that the minimum number of bookings is not attained, you may be rebooked or transferred on to another liveaboard of the same standard and with our guides.

- Discovery for Touristic Investment reserves the right to cancel a trip for other reasons that are unpredictable and beyond our control. In this circumstance we will inform the customer at the earliest possible date. In the event of a cancellation, we will assist in trying to locate a suitable replacement vessel or dive resort, only if this was not possible we will provide a full refund of the amount paid.
- Discovery for Touristic Investment will not be held responsible for any related costs (i.e. flights, hotels, or any other such costs) the client might have in conjunction with this trip.

Cancellation Due to Force Majeure

- Discovery shall not accept any financial responsibility for any itinerary changes or cancellations resulting from circumstances outside of Discovery for Touristic Investment control, such as, but not limited to, those stated below in Force Majeure.
- Discovery for Touristic Investment reserves the right to modify, delay and/or cancel diving arrangements where the remoteness or inaccessibility of the diving destination, acts of God (including fire, flood, earthquake, storm, hurricane or other natural disaster), war, political unrest and other hostilities (regardless of whether war is declared), or other technical difficulties, failure of machinery-

- equipment, etc. which may cause the arrangements to become unsafe, perilous and/ or impracticable.

- Where adverse weather conditions prevail, making it dangerous or inadvisable for customers or the boat to land on and enter port, the Captain shall reserve the right to delay or postpone sailing until more favorable conditions prevail. This may involve an adjustment to the itinerary and/or re-sequencing of diving site.
- Discovery for Touristic Investment will not be held responsible for any related costs (i.e. flights, hotels, or any other such costs) the client might have in conjunction with this trip.
- In the event of a cancellation due to force majeure, we will assist in trying to locate a suitable replacement vessel or dive resort, only if this was not possible we will provide a full refund of the amount paid. Discovery for Touristic Investment will not be held responsible for any related costs (i.e. flights, hotels, or any other such costs) the client might have in conjunction with this trip.

Customer's Obligations

Where the customer is negligent or irresponsible, and causes any damage to, or loss of property and equipment belonging to Discovery for Touristic Investment, the customer shall recompense us in full, to the current market value of any lost or damaged item.

- The customer should be physically, emotionally and mentally prepared and fit to participate in the activities they have signed up for. Any resultant injury or discomfort borne out of any unfitness shall not provide any ground for complaint or refund.
- Discovery for Touristic Investment may prohibit an individual's participation on a dive(s), where they are physically, mentally or emotionally unfit to dive, demonstrate a distinct lack of respect for National Marine Park rules and regulations, handle or harm marine life, consume alcohol between dives, or fail to abide by general international safe diving standards and practices.
- You must at all times strictly comply with all applicable laws and regulations of all the relevant countries and regions. Should you fail to comply with the above or commit any illegal act during a Trip or, if in the opinion of Discovery for Touristic Investment, your behavior is causing or is likely to cause danger, distress or material annoyance to others, Discovery for Touristic Investment may cancel your travel arrangements on any product or service immediately at your expense and without any liability on us. You will not be entitled to any refund for unused or missed services or costs incurred as a result of termination of your travel arrangements, including, without limitation, return travel, accommodations, meals, and incidentals.

- Children: No children under the age of 4 will be allowed on a Liveboard. Children over the age of 4 years must be supervised by a parent or designated responsible adult at all times.
- Egyptian Law recommends the following:
 1. Marine Park Cruises such as Brothers, Daedalus, Rocky, Zabargad) all guests have a minimum of 50 logged dives.
 2. Wrecks: All guests have a minimum of 50 logged dives
 3. South & St. Johns: All guests have a minimum of 40 logged dives
 4. Fury Shoal & Safaga: All guests have a minimum of 30 logged dives

Additional Notes

- Discovery for Touristic Investment highly recommends that all divers obtain Diving and Travel Insurance to cover expenses which may arise in the event of any unforeseen/unfortunate circumstances.
- Jurisdiction
 - The contract between you and Discovery for Touristic Investment is made on the terms of these booking conditions, which are governed by Egyptian Law and clients shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the Egyptian courts.
