

1 Day Excursion Tour IN CAIRO

Egyptian Museum, Citadel of Salah Din and Old Cairo

Duration 8 hrs approx.

Take in some of Cairo's top sights, including the Egyptian Museum, Citadel and Old Cairo, with the aid of a private guide during this 8-hour day trip. Discover the more than 160,000 priceless artifacts at the Egyptian Museum, some dating back as far as 5,000 years. Continue your trip back through Egypt's history at its Citadel, constructed in the 12th century to ward off invaders, and see the city's Coptic area and Ben Ezra synagogue. Your Cairo sightseeing trip covers a private Egyptologist guide and vehicle, lunch, entrance fees and round-trip hotel transport.

It exhibits a rare collection of over 250,000 genuine artifacts that date as far back as 5000 years, including an exclusive exhibit dedicated to the Tutankhamen - A collection of treasures, gold, and jewelry that were buried in his tomb for over 3,500 years before they were discovered in the 1920s when his tomb was excavated. The Citadel was fortified by the Ayyubid ruler Salah al-Din (Saladin) between 1176 and 1183 CE, to protect it from the Crusaders.[1] Only a few years after defeating the Fatimid Caliphate, Saladin set out to build a wall that would surround both Cairo and Fustat, then we will move to visit the Coptic area where you can see the church of Abu-Sergah and ST, Barbara, the hanging church, the old Jewish synagogue-Ben Ezra .

Afterwards, drive to Sakkara, the biggest cemetery, to see the step pyramids and some tombs before heading to Memphis where you can see the oldest capital of Egypt, as well as the famous pyramids of King Senfru in Dahahsur. There, you can enter the red pyramids and see the bent pyramids. After a short drive, have lunch (included) at a good quality restaurant overlooking the Sphinx and the pyramids. After lunch you will be transferred back to your hotel. Always be connected during the tour in your private air-conditioned van through Wi-Fi access to send photos on the spot and chat with family and friends

Museum Alabaster Mosque Hanging Church and Khan Bazaar from Cairo

Duration: 8 hrs approx..

Visit four of Cairo's star attractions and explore Old Cairo on this full-day tour, including lunch, with an Egyptologist guide. Visit the Egyptian Museum to see Tutankhamun's funerary mask and more; and view the Mosque of Mohamed Ali, otherwise called the Alabaster Mosque. Delve into the ancient lanes of Old Cairo to see the famous Hanging Church, other Coptic churches and the Synagogue of Ben Ezra. Finish at the Khan el-Khalili bazaar, Cairo's old souk, with free time to explore the narrow alleyways and shop for handicrafts, jewelry and trinkets.

Full-day tour of Cairo's Egyptian Museum, Mohammed Ali Mosque, Hanging Church and Khan el-Khalili bazaar. Visit the Egyptian Museum and see Tutankhamun's treasures, including the boy king's gold death mask. Admire the Mosque of Mohamed Ali, otherwise known as the Alabaster Mosque. Head into Old Cairo to see the Hanging Church, built on a ruined Roman fortress. See other Coptic churches and the Synagogue of Ben Ezra. Explore the colorful Khan el-Khalili bazaar at leisure and shop for handicrafts and other goodies. Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant and discover Cairo's history from an Egyptologist guide.

What You Can Expect

Enjoy the best of what Cairo has to offer. Meet your Egyptologist tour guide in the lobby of your hotel and start your journey by visiting the Egyptian museum to see the famous gold mask made for King Tut. The museum displays more than 136,000 artifacts from the Pharaonic periods in Egypt. Then continue on to see the mosque built for Mohamed Ali Pasha, which is a unique mosque made of alabaster and covered by lead from outside. Next, you'll make a stop to have lunch in a good quality restaurant overlooking the Nile. Time to pay a visit to the old Cairo area to see the famous church (Hanging Church, Church of Abu Serga and Synagogue of Ben Ezra), before exploring the Khan El Khalil market. Explore the market at your own leisure.
